
APPLICATION

- · To ventilate the roof. Allows evaporation of water vapour trapped in the support.
- · APPLICATION METHOD:
- 1. Make a circular cut in the waterproofing membrane and remove it.
- 2. Place the roof vent on the support.
- 3. Have a rectangular reinforcement of the membrane that is large enough to cover the cut section in item 1, and insert it through the hole in the center of the vent.
- 4. Weld the reinforcement with the vent and the waterproofing membrane with a flame.
- 5. Protect the vent elbow fittings with another reinforcement in the shape of a collar.
- · QUANTITY REQUIRED:
- It is recommended to use one roof vent for every 40 m²..
